### WHAT IS A SPECIAL NEED?



Students with special needs have a long-term physical or psychological or intellectual or

sensory impairment, which may hinder their full and effective participation on an equal basis in their course.

#### Examples:

Visual- or Hearing-impaired student.


A student with a chronic/life-threatening physical disease.

Student with ADHD, Autistic spectrum disorder, or learning disabilities.

"Reasonable accommodation" means any modification or adjustment to the CAMPUS environment that will enable a student with a disability to have access to or to participate or advance in academia. These measures ensure that students with special needs enjoy equal opportunities. A student must share all the necessary information for accommodation via email,

## EVIDENCE/DOCUMENT NEEDED



- 1. Initial evidence/ medical reports to be no older than 3 years (we then provide the concession for 3 years which means that we use the report for 6 years)
- 2. Students must email the request with the above documents to the Inclusion committee: <a href="mailto:inclusion@eduvos.com">inclusion@eduvos.com</a>
- 3. Should a student require that the above concession be extended beyond the specified period, an application for an extension should be submitted, to ensure that the institution has the resources to accommodate the student and that the student's best interest is the key concern
